CAMPUS OUTLIERS AND HIGHLIGHTS

Although each highlighted campus is unique, both share key factors that contribute to their success. Each school has demonstrated a strong commitment to strengthening campus systems and developing a deeper understanding of their students’ needs to create conditions where students are better supported.

Webb Middle School - Band 1

Webb Middle School is in the first year of a District-managed restart for the 2025-26 school year. Webb Administrators attribute the success of reducing exclusionary discipline actions to participating in MTSS training and coaching, frequent grade level Child Study Team Meetings with guidance from the MTSS Office, positive behavior interventions, use of MTSS behavior curriculum and interventions, veteran teacher leadership, and a strong leadership team.

Bailey Middle School - Band 3

Currently in their second year together, the Bailey Middle School's Administration Team attributes the campus' success to their intentional work in building a strong culture of restorative practices and MTSS systems. The MTSS department has provided extensive support in refining their MTSS practices. The Administration Team indicates that trust and connection are growing on campus as indicated by students regularly seeking out their administrators and counselors to collaboratively problem-solve conflicts. The Administration Team works toward creating and sustaining a positive and supportive environment by consistently reinforcing behavior expectations and celebrating students.
