### How many AISD students took the ACT at each high school and how well did they perform?

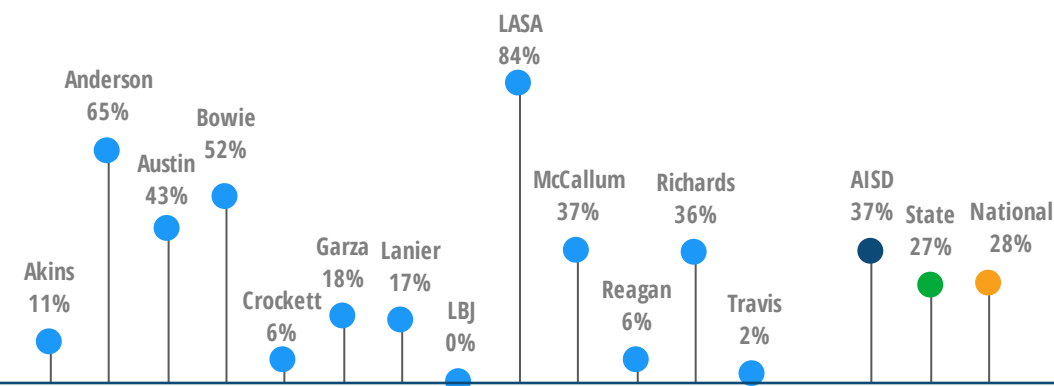
AISD students' participation in ACT testing continued to increase in 2015 (N = 1,601), compared with participation in the prior year (N=1,499) ACT results were mixed between campuses.

### Purpose

This report describes ACT test campus-level results for Austin Independent School District (AISD) students in the 2014–2015 school year. The ACT is a national college admissions examination developed and administered by ACT, Inc. that consists of the following subject area tests: English, mathematics (math), reading, and scientific reasoning. The highest score possible on each section of the ACT is 36. Students generally take the ACT during their junior or senior year of high school, and many colleges and universities use the ACT to make admission decisions.
