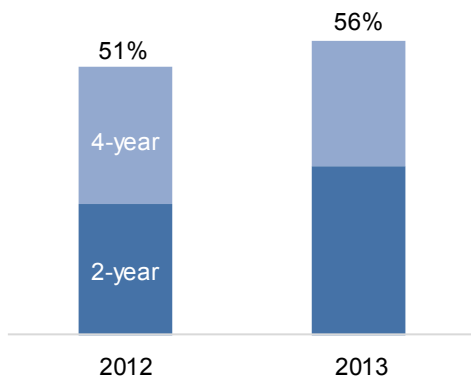

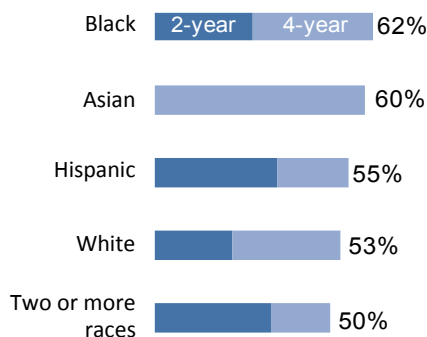

Higher percentages of Black and Asian graduates enrolled in postsecondary institutions than did their peers of other races.

graduates enrolled in college the first year after graduation.

graduates were direct-to-college enrollees.



74% of graduates who completed the FAFSA enrolled in college.

53% of economically disadvantaged graduates enrolled in college.

14% of limited English proficient graduates enrolled in college.
