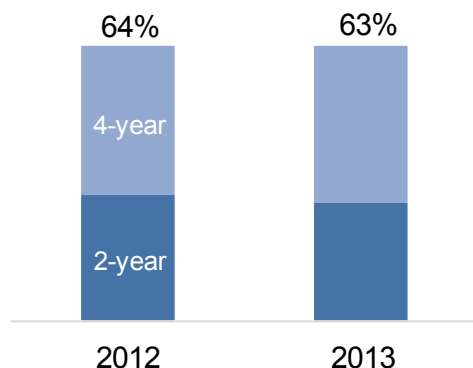

of graduates who completed the FAFSA enrolled in college.

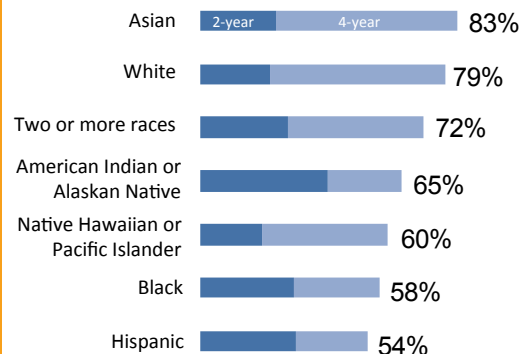
50%

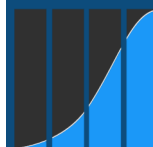
