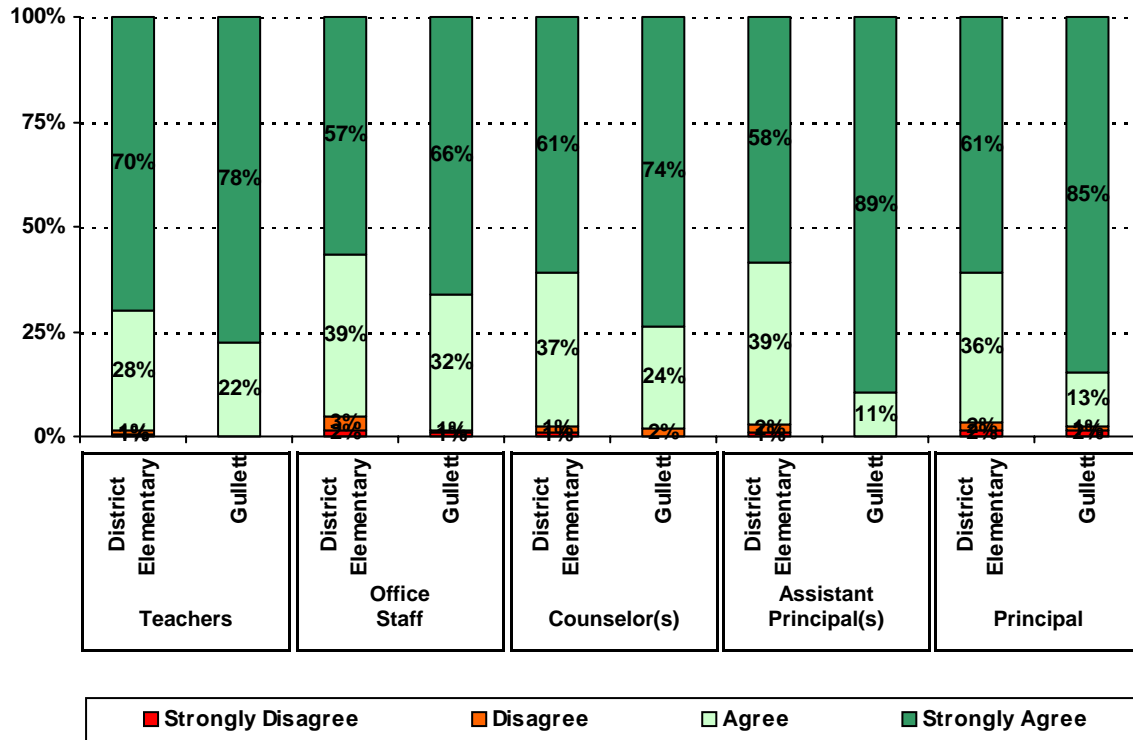

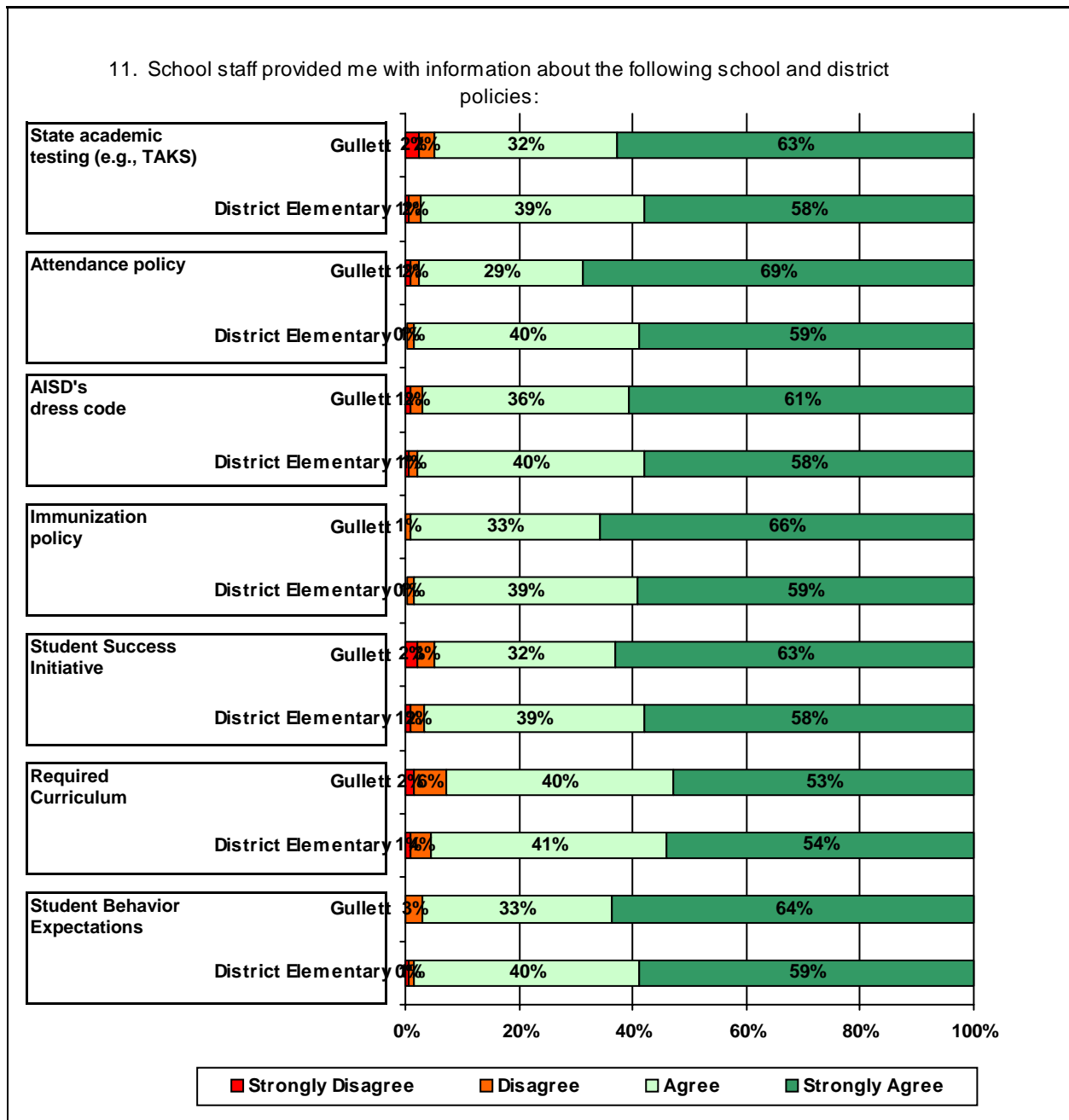
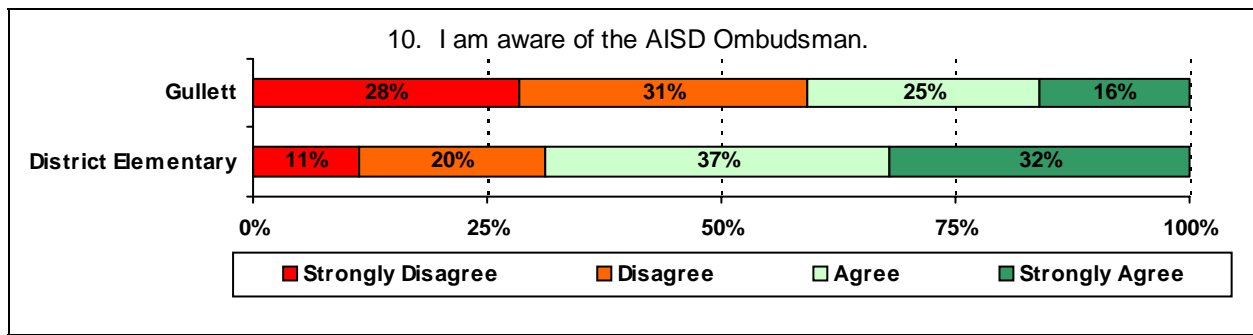


4. The following school staff provide me with opportunities for two-way communication.

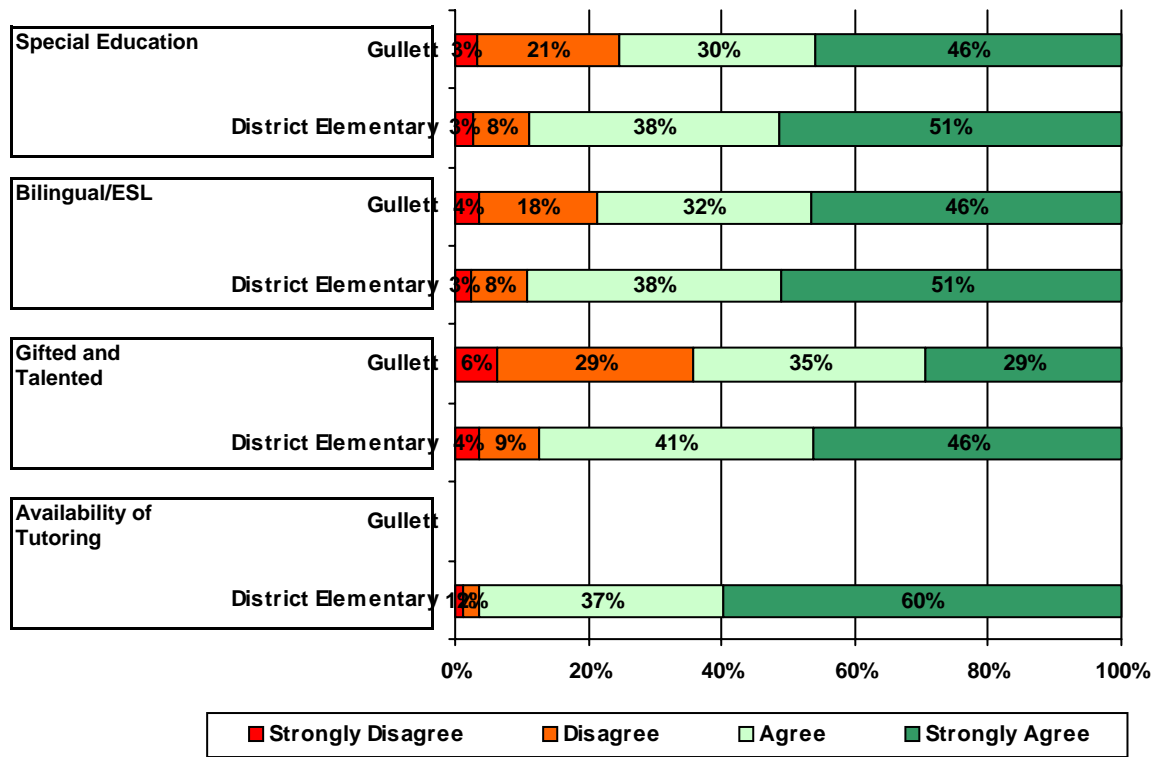




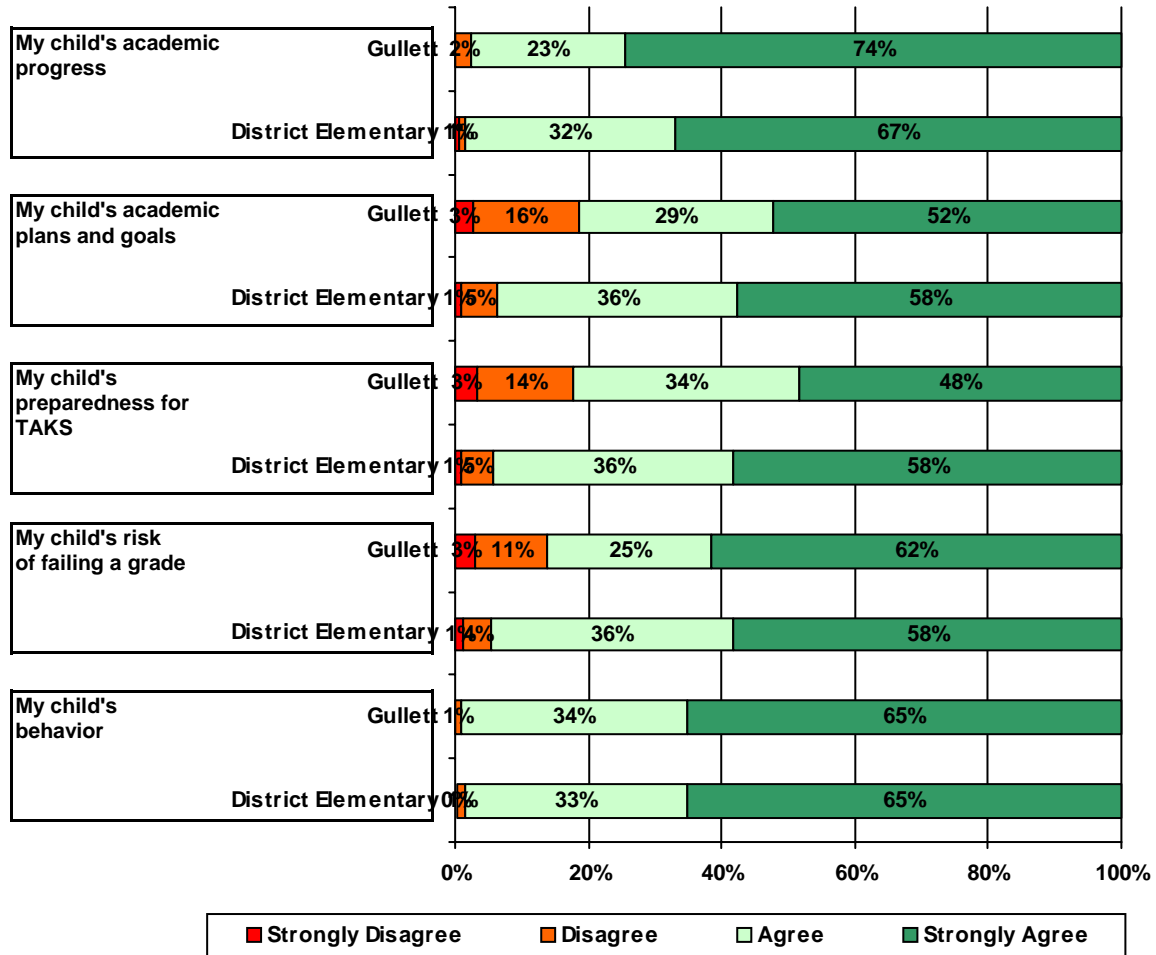
