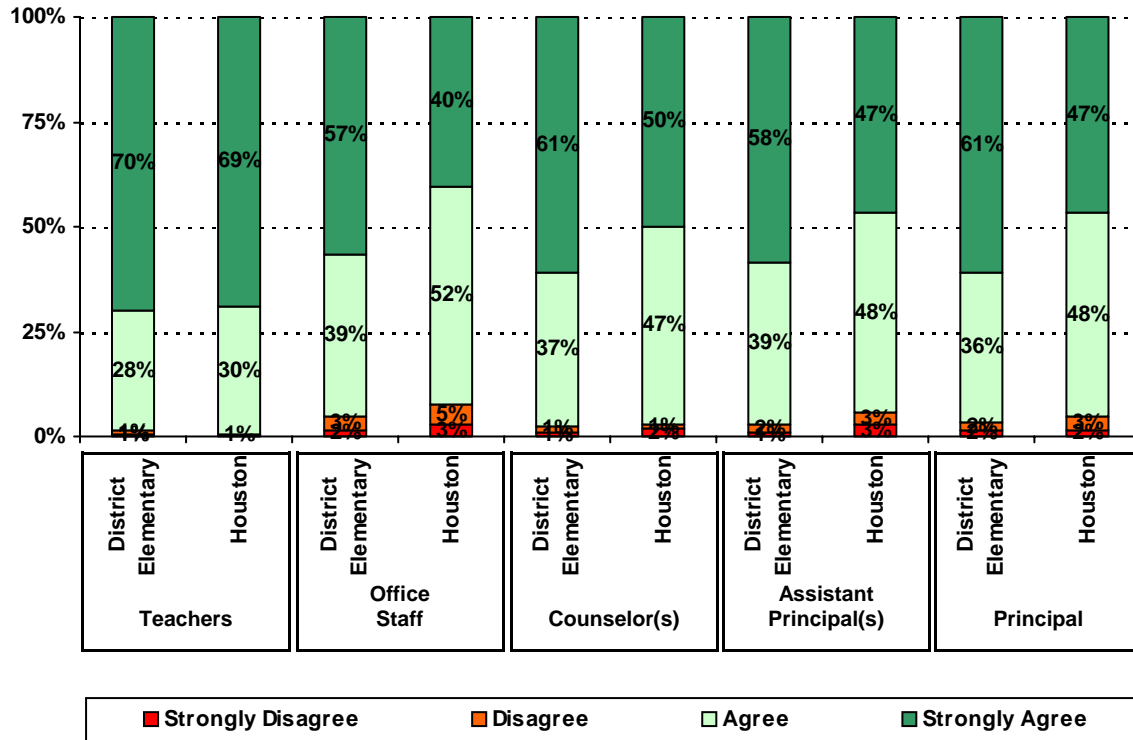

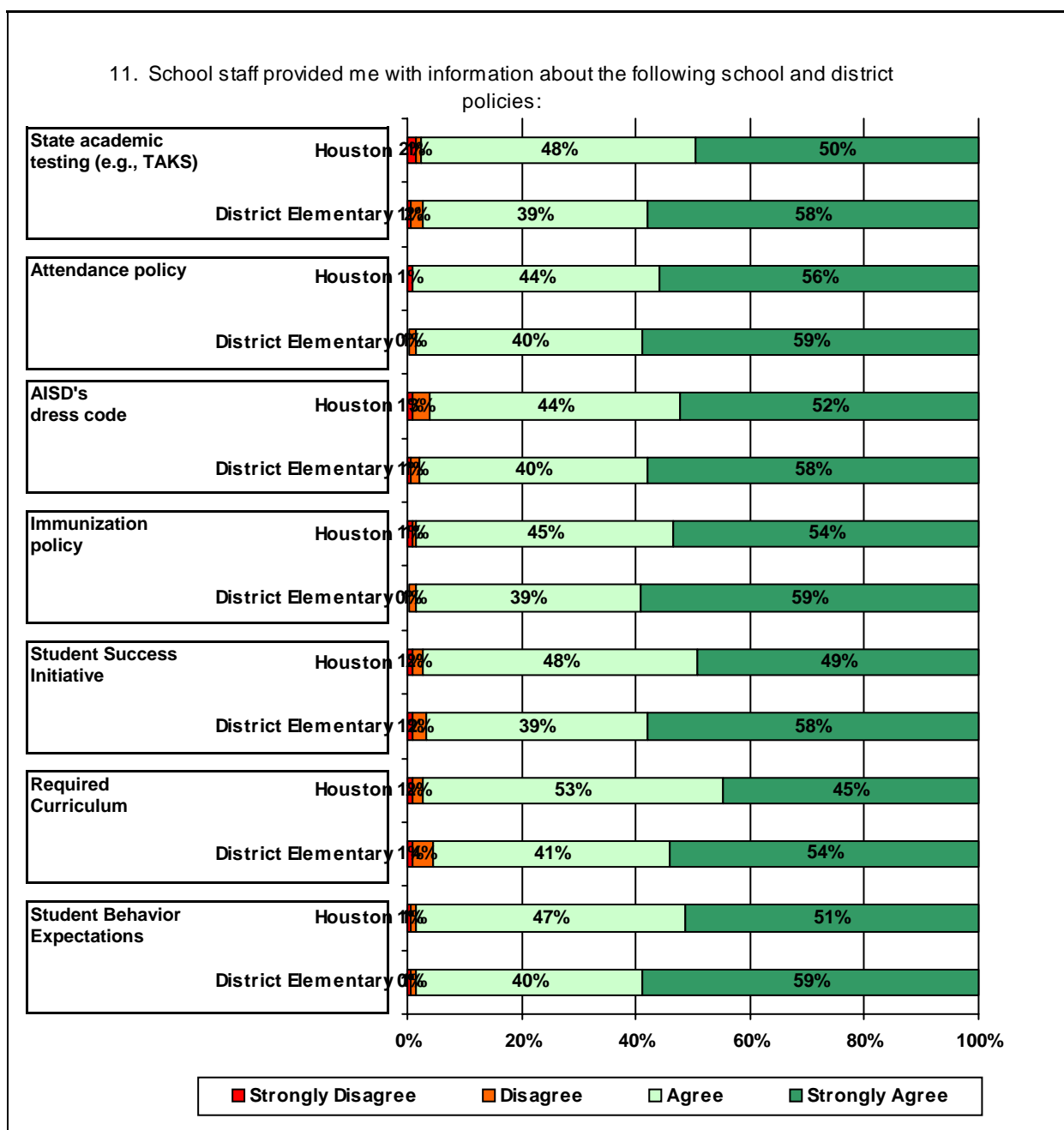
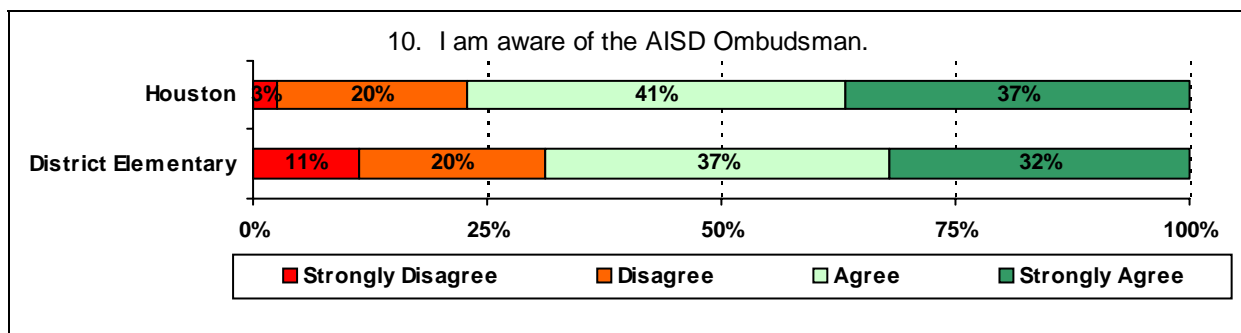


4. The following school staff provide me with opportunities for two-way communication.

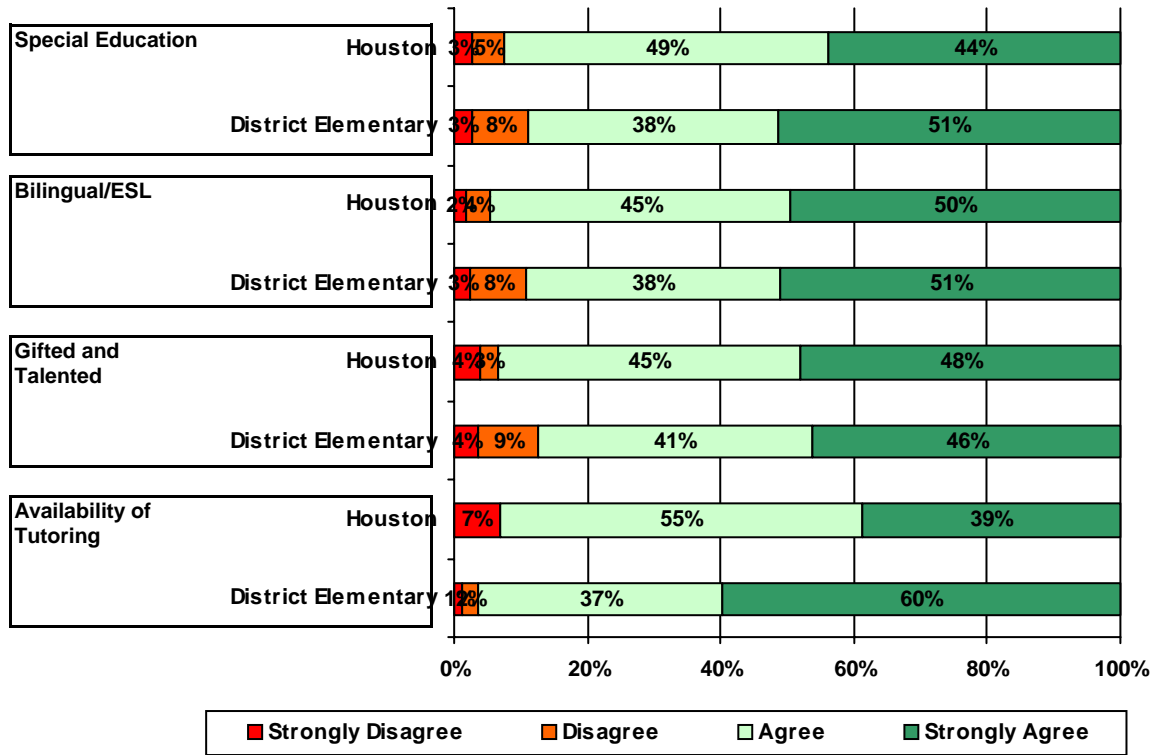




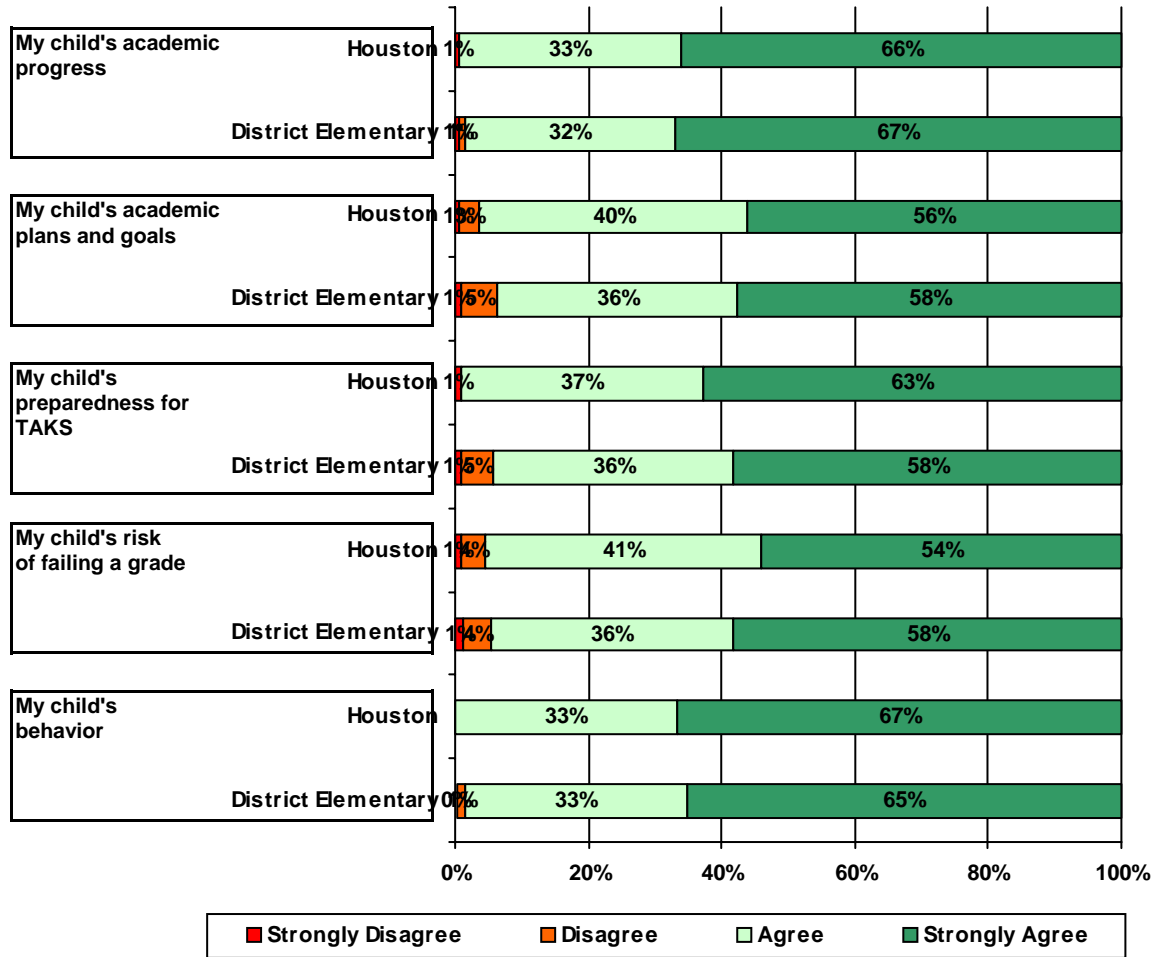




12. School staff provided me with information about the following programs:
