

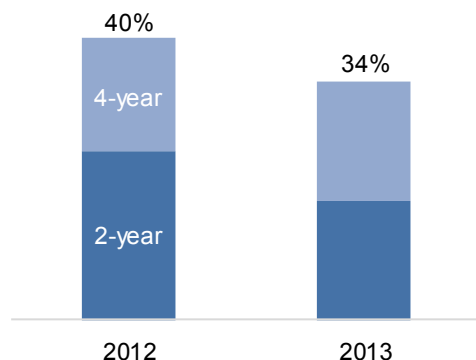

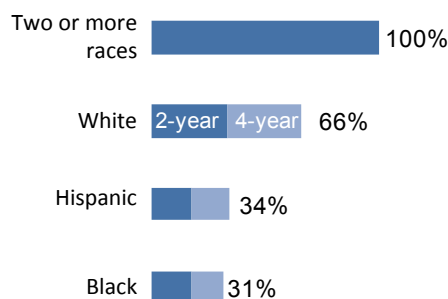
Graduating Class of 2013
