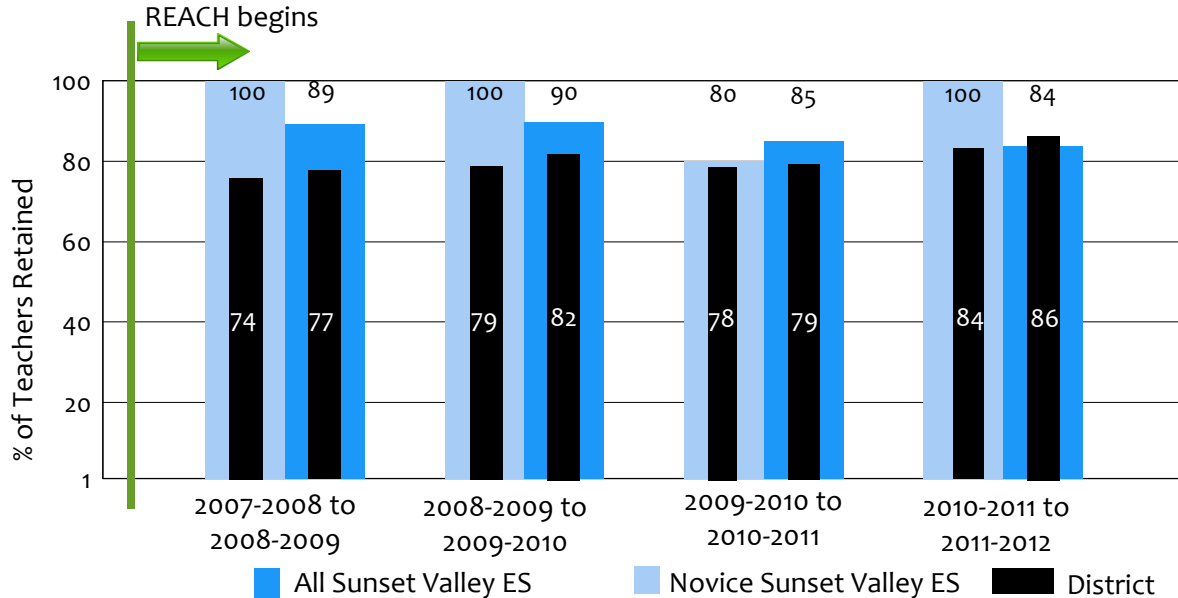

Note. Teachers affected by the reduction in force (RIF) are excluded.

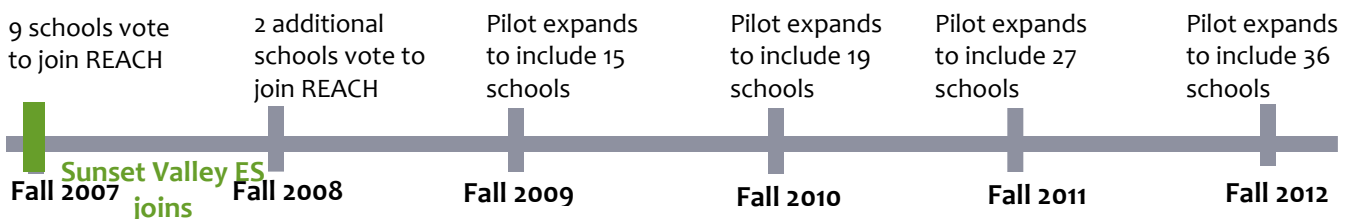

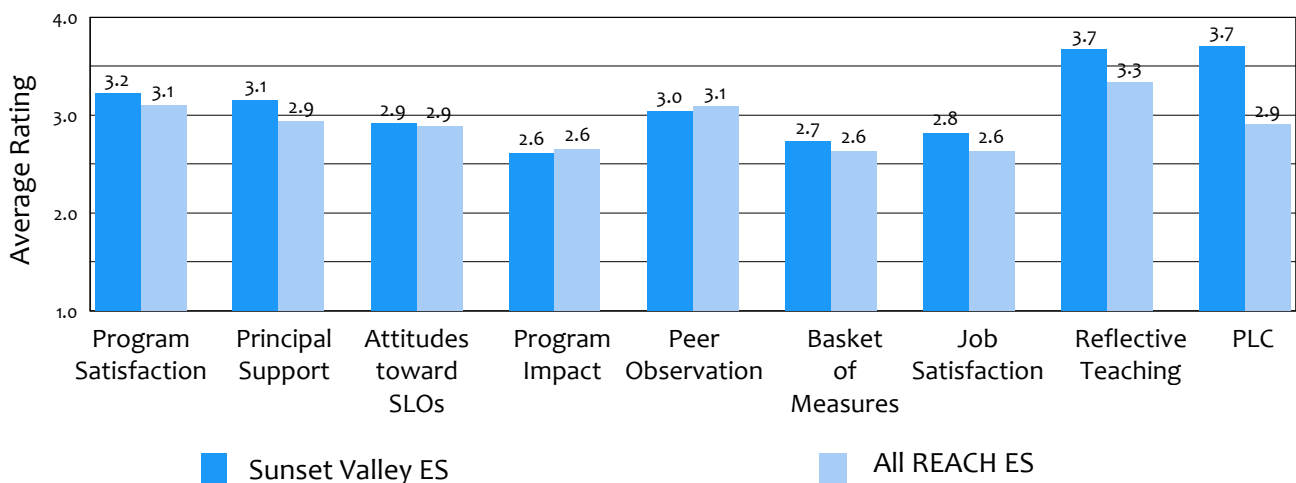
