 As approved by the AISD Board of Trustees, our school district is beginning the process of bringing Campus Health Room Staff back in-house. As such, the 2023-24 School Year will consist of:

- AISD School Nurses and Health Room Assistants at High Schools
- EDU Healthcare (contractor) will be covering Middle Schools
- Ascension Seton (contractor) will be covering Elementary Schools and Rosedale
- AISD Fentanyl Awareness Campaign has a new home. The BOND Emergency Management Director, in conjunction with the Board of Trustees, will be spearheading the district response with the help of district and community subject matter experts. The Health Services and Nursing department will continue lending assistance at the request of the Board.
- COVID-19 is a state-reportable condition in Texas, and the district will continue asking campuses to report to our department. These data are compiled and submitted to website managers for the weekly district dashboard and reported to Austin Public Health (APH).

SHAC members asked follow-up questions about nurse coverage at schools, especially concerning middle schools. They also were concerned about the confidentiality of students from the third party contractors.

Pat will relay the questions to Health Services and bring the answers back to SHAC.

#### **Mental Health:**

There will be a full presentation on 10-18-23 by the Mental Health Counseling Department.

SHAC members questioned the impact of several bills on AISD including HB 3, SB 763, and HB18. They discussed the advantages and disadvantages of taking a formal stand with the board without coming to a consensus.
