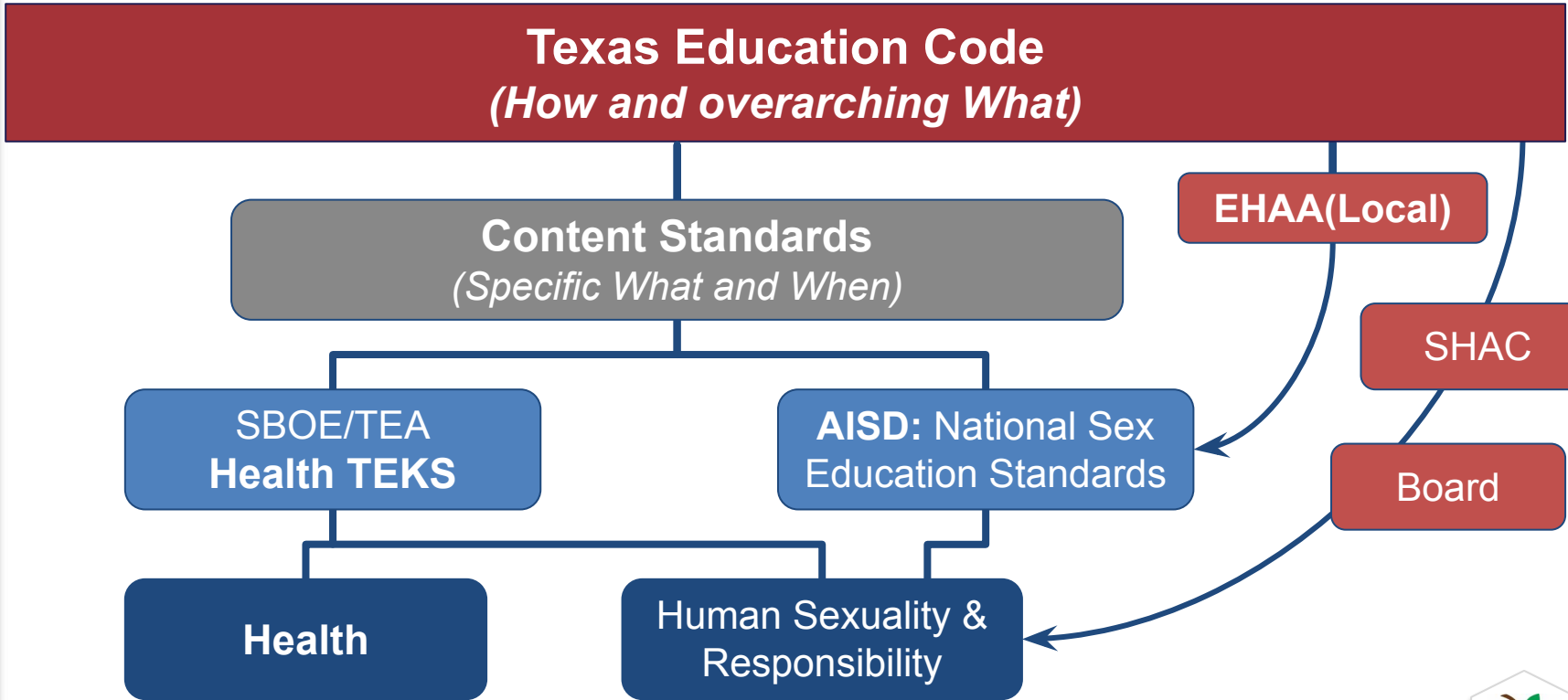

Texas Education Code *HB 1525*

- Open Meetings Act
- Audio/Video Recordings
- Two meetings for public comment on any curriculum changes
- ★ Board must make resolution to instigate curriculum changes

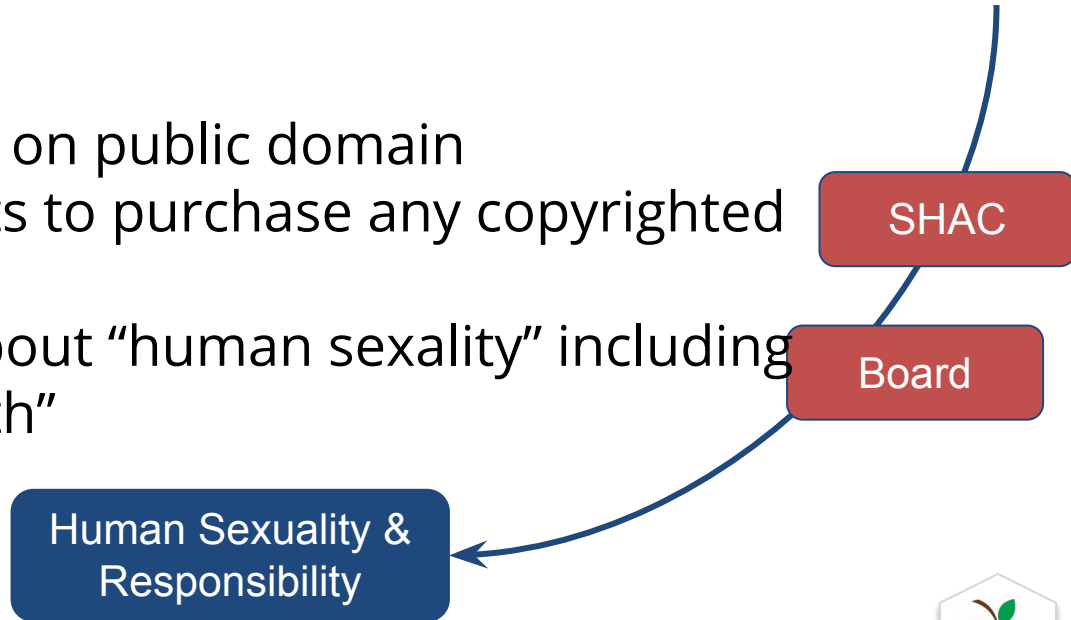

Health and Sex Education Updates

Texas Education Code *HB 1525*

- Opt-In Model
- Post HSR materials on public domain
- Parent/Family rights to purchase any copyrighted curriculum
- Added language about “human sexuality” including “reproductive health”

Starting 2022-2023

**SBOE/TEA
Health TEKS**

- TEKS Updated in 2020
- Significantly longer and include more content across all strands

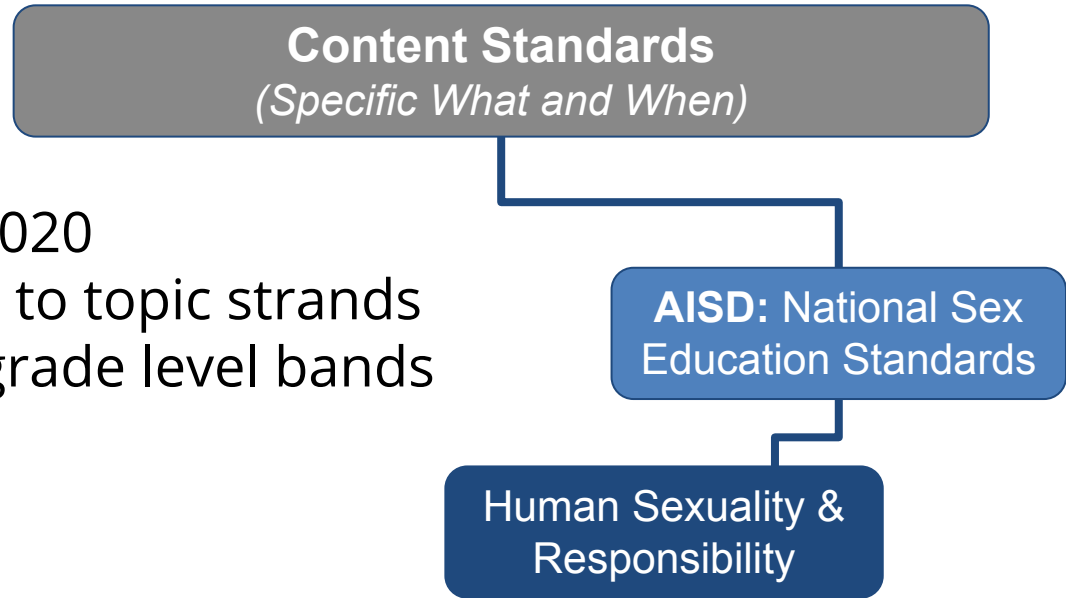
**Human Sexuality &

- Reproductive and Sexual Health strand content begins at grade 4



Health and Sex Education Updates

- NSES updated in 2020
 - Minor changes to topic strands
 - More specific grade level bands



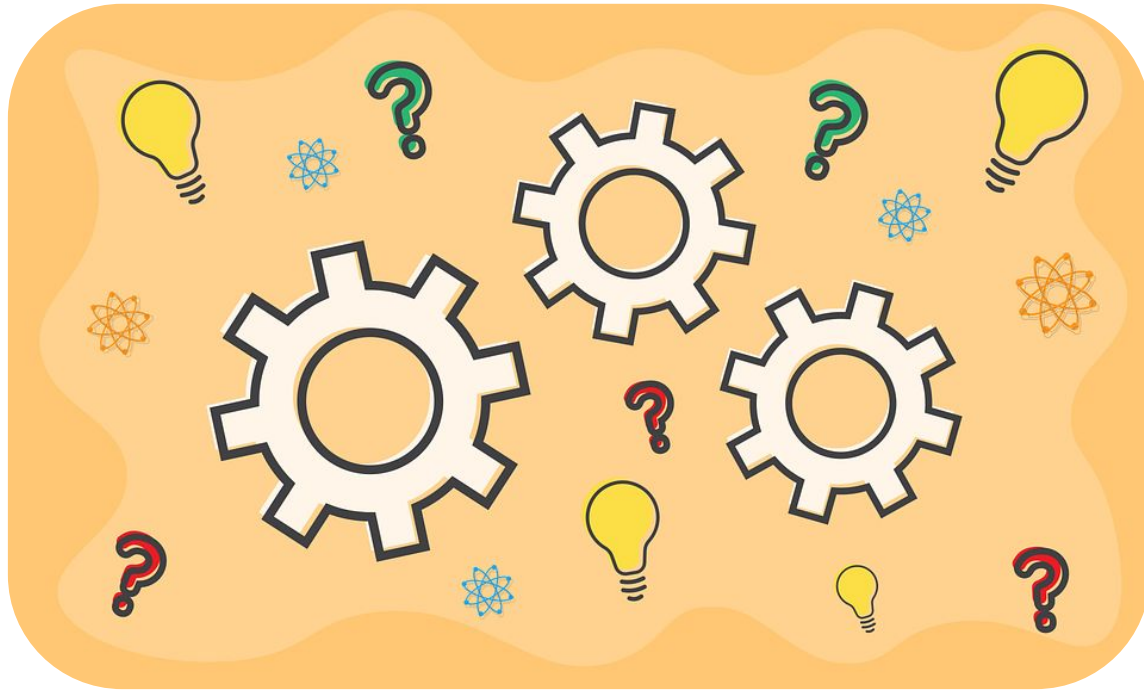
Because of all of that...

- All lessons (K-12) for health and human sexuality will be reviewed and revised following TEC, TAC, and EHAA processes
Spring/Summer 2022
- HSR grades 3-HS is already approved and will be **implemented this fall** (permission letters go out 2 weeks prior to lessons being taught)
- **The process for approving HSR for grades K-2 will be delayed and lessons not implemented until fall 2022**

Timeline

Sept 2021	Teacher Training
Oct/Nov 2021	HSR 3-HS Permission Letters (Opt-In)
Nov/Dec 2021	HSR 3-HS Implementation
Jan/Feb 2022	Curriculum Alignment with Updated Standards
Mar/Apr 2022	SHAC Review and Community Input, including K-2
May 2022	Recommendations to the Board & Board Vote
Summer 2022	Final Updates as Requested by the Board
Fall 2022	Implementation of Updated Health and HSR Curriculum
